7. Request by Shanta Puchtler of Palfrey Street for traffic safety improvements on Palfrey Street.
8. Request by Ms. Heather Carroll of Bromfield Street for the installation of a No Parking Here to Corner sign on the west side of Evans Street 20 feet north of Waltham Street.
9. Request by Mr. Evan Wilcox of Hawthorne Street for an all-way stop at the intersection of Fayette Street at Pearl Street.
