1. Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 12:04 PM

2. Roll Call

Present, all by zoom, were Liz Aeschlimann, Sarah Zoen, and Susan Musinsky. Also present by zoom were Human Rights Commissioner Gabriel Camacho and Captain Dan Unsworth of the police department.

a. Human Rights Commission Action Plan for next twelve months

The duration of the action plan was also discussed, with the subcommittee settling on July 1, 2025 to June 30, 2026. The subcommittee also considered the proposal that the Human Rights Commission has received to take the lead on the city's Juneteenth event. Further, the subcommittee considered how best to leverage the liaisons, including the new student liaisons, in the Human Rights Commission's work .
