4. Request by Ms. Elaine Martin of Lexington Street and Ms. Janice Connolly of Pierce Road to prohibit parking on the south side of Belmont Street to the west and east of Pierce Road.
5. Request by Ms. Elaine Martin and Ms. Janice Connolly to prohibit parking on the east side of Pierce Road to the north and south of the driveway at #36 Pierce Road.
6. Request by Mr. Higor and Mrs. Kettely Fernandes of Summer Street to prohibit parking on the west side of Whites Avenue from a point 23' north of Summer Street to Summer Street.
7. Request by City Administration to implement safety improvements at the intersection of the Watertown Greenway and Cottage Street.
8. Request by Sgt. Sampson to prohibit parking on west side of Irving Street from North Beacon Street to a point 100 feet south.
9. Request by City Administration to discuss the provisions of Chapter 218 of the Acts of 2016, Section 193. These provisions would establish a speed limit of 25 miles per hour on any roadway inside a thickly settled or business district on any way that is not a state highway, and establish designated 20 mile per hour safety zones on, at or near any way in the city or town which is not a state highway
