

WBSC 2/4/21 Minutes

1. Dr. McManus Called the meeting to order at 7:02 PM
2. Registration application for Aldatu Biosciences
 - Dr. McManus gave a brief overview of the registration requirements
 - The WBSC voted 5-0 to recommended the Board of Health approve Aldatu Biosciences' registration application
3. Permit application for RootPath
 - Mr. Ramdin informed the WBSC that not all the application material had been submitted
 - The WBSC voted to table RootPath's application to the March WBSC meeting
4. Procedural Discussions
 - Discussed outreach to existing companies to encourage they submit applications ASAP
 - The Health Department will send a letter of intent to companies and look into in person outreach
 - A press release will be sent to the Watertown Tab and Watertown News reminding companies that they must be in compliance by July 1st, 2021
 - Discussed shorting company presentations from a 20-minute presentation to a 5-minute oral, high-level overview. This was decided due to the high volume of upcoming applications
 - Since the presentation is shortened, supplying the WBSC with IBC meeting minutes prior to coming before the WBSC is crucial
 - Can the WBSC put out a call for IBC community representatives?
 - Health Department will help with a graphic for this
 - Discussed possible outreach to the Watertown Business Coalition
 - Discussed having Steve Magoon, from Watertown Community Development come to a future WBSC to discuss new Life Science Developments in town
