The next meeting of the Watertown Traffic Commission will be held on Wednesday September 29, 2021 in the Council Chambers, 149 Main Street, Watertown, MA at 1:30 p.m. The following items are on the agenda for discussion:

1. Approve the minutes of the June, 2021 Commission meeting.
2. Request by Mr. Anthony Sansevero of Birch Road to restrict one parking space in front of 22/24 Birch Road to Handicap Only parking.
3. Request by Ms. Carol Horowitz of Townly Road to restrict parking on the east side of Townly Road from a point 76' south of Belmont Street to Belmont Street.
4. Request by Mr. Jay Prujapati, General Manager of Yogi's General Market at 218 Waverley Avenue to limit two parking spaces in front of the business to 15-minute parking.
5. Request by Mr. Drumil Modi of Parker Street to install cautionary "Slow Children" signage on both sides of Parker Street.
6. Request by Dr. Julie Perreault of Galen Holdings, LLC at 98 Galen Street to restrict parking in front of 98 Galen Street.
7. Request by Ms. Jessica Yamas of Avon Road on behalf of several Avon Road residents to implement the following parking and traffic measures:
 - a. Placement of "No Parking Here to Corner" signage on the west side of Avon Road
 - i. 20 feet from the southwest corner of Avon Road at Sunset Road
 - ii. 20 feet from the northwest corner of Avon Road at Sunset Road, and
 - iii. 20 feet from the northwest corner of Avon Road at Belmont Street
 - b. Placement of "No Parking Here to Corner" signage on Belmont Street
 - i. 20 feet west of Avon Road
 - ii. 20 feet east of Avon Road
 - c. Restrict traffic onto Sunset Road (Do Not Enter) from 7:00-9:00 a.m. and 4:00-6:00 p.m. except residents and deliveries
 - d. Restrict parking on Avon Road to Residents Only Parking and install appropriate signage
 - e. Create resident dashboard parking placards for Avon Road residents
8. Request by Ms. Megan Predina of Maple Street on behalf of several Maple Street residents to implement the following parking and traffic measures:
 - a. Install additional speed limit signage on both sides of Maple Street
 - b. Install speed limit signage on Hunt Street
 - c. Install cautionary "Slow Children" signage on both sides of Maple Street
 - d. Install a stop sign at the end of the 50 Hunt Street commercial driveway that leads to Maple Street
 - e. Install an isolated stop sign on Hunt Street at Maple Street



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- f. Install an isolated stop sign at 37 Hunt Street
 - g. Install a marked walking zone on the pavement of Hunt Street where there is no sidewalk
 - h. Install a crosswalk spanning Hunt Street at Maple Street
 - i. Install a crosswalk spanning Maple Street at Hunt Street and include yield to pedestrian signage
 - j. Install a crosswalk spanning Maple Street at Jefferson Street
 - k. Install a crosswalk on the sidewalk across the 50 Hunt Street commercial driveway
 - l. Install a speed bump or rumble strips on Maple Street
