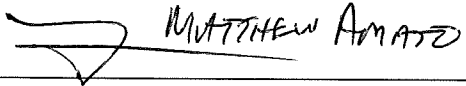


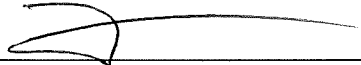
To Whom It May Concern,

WorldTech Engineering is pleased to submit this memorandum summarizing our recommendation for signage modification at the intersection of Common Street and Spring Street.

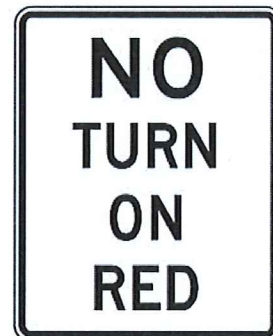
There is a bike box on the Common Street southbound approach to the Common Street/ Spring Street intersection. In accordance with the FHWA Interim Approval for Optional Use of an Intersection Bicycle Box (IA-18), a No Turn on Red Sign is required.

Turns on red shall be prohibited from the approach where a bicycle box is placed using a NO TURN ON RED (R10-11 series) sign.

Since the sign is a regulatory sign, it should be approved by the Watertown Traffic Commission.

The recommended "No Turn on Red" sign is a R10-11a sign. The size should be 24" x 30". The sign can be mounted either on the signal post on the southwest corner of the intersection, or on a separate sign post on this same corner.

A photo is shown on the next page identifying the potential location for the sign.
