### RESOLUTION # 85

2019 – R – 85

### NAMING POLICY FOR SQUARES OR INTESECTIONS FOR NON-VETERANS

**WHEREAS:** The Town of Watertown seeks to have a formal policy for the naming of Squares or Intersections for non-Veterans, as a formal policy for Veteran Memorials and Dedications was adopted by the Town Council on July 12, 2016.

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:** That the Town Council of the City known as the Town of Watertown adopts this Naming Policy for Squares and Intersections for Non-Veterans:

1. **INTRODUCTION** – The Town Council shall have sole authority for the naming of Squares or Intersections in the public right-of-way under the control of the Town of Watertown.
  - a) The Town Council understands that said naming may have long-lasting effects and will span future generations whose perceptions and values might change.
  - b) The Town Council intends to be cautious exercising the Policy to avoid over-naming Squares or Intersections.
2. **PURPOSE** – The Town Council believes that the naming of Squares or Intersections is a matter of substantial or significant public interest and deserves careful consideration.
  - a) The Town Council, therefore, creates this policy to establish a systematic, consistent and transparent approach for naming Squares or Intersections in Watertown.
  - b) This policy is for non-veterans only, as there is a separate policy for naming of Squares or Intersections for veteran processed through the Veterans Service Officer.
3. **PROCESS** – Any Watertown resident may propose in writing that a Square or Intersection be named for a notable non-veteran with specific ties to Watertown.

- a) The proposal shall be submitted to the Town Council President, and must include documentation to support the rationale for the naming including a broad level of community backing.
  - b) The Town Council President, upon determining the proposal is complete, shall place it on a Town Council agenda for a vote of referral to the Public Works Committee for review and recommendation.
  - c) The Department of Public Works shall review the proposal and provide the Public Works Committee an analysis as to the appropriateness of signage at the location taking into account matters such as traffic conditions, sightlines, and planned road construction projects.
  - d) The Public Works Committee shall review the proposal and the Department of Public Works analysis, and develop a recommendation for the Town Council
  - e) The Town Council will vote on a resolution to name a Square or Intersection per the Public Works Committee recommendation.
4. **CRITERIA** – In deciding the appropriateness of any naming proposal, the Town Council shall consider the following:
- a) The public interest to be served by honoring the individual.
  - b) The leadership role or distinguished service of the individual, considering the quality of contribution along with the length of service.
  - c) The association the individual has with the proposed naming location.
5. **REVIEW** – The Town Council shall have sole authority to remove the naming of any Square or Intersection if, with the passage of time, it determines the public interest is no longer being served.

Dear Council Members,

The members of the Pigsgusset Initiative, a working group of Watertown Citizens for Peace, Justice and the Environment, would like to thank all of you for holding the hearing (6/21/22) to consider the petition that we submitted requesting that the name of the Columbus Delta be reconsidered. We greatly appreciate your vote to move our request forward to the Public Works Committee for review and recommendations, and we look forward to that discussion.

It was recently brought to our attention that you did not see the signatures of the nearly 180 Watertown residents who signed the petition, so, for your information, we are attaching copies of the signed pages of the petition. (click [HERE](#) for copies of the petition).

We want to reiterate that we see our request as an issue of fairness and inclusion. As last Tuesday's hearing illustrated, people hold many strong feelings about Christopher Columbus, both positive and negative. We cannot resolve the controversies surrounding him and the history that occurred over 400 years ago, but we can focus on what the Delta means to the many diverse groups who hold ceremonies and vigils in that space in the 21st century. Our goal is to find a new name with which a broader swath of our community can identify. In this move toward greater inclusion, we also want to be sure to recognize and include the Indigenous people who lived on these lands for thousands of years before colonial settlers arrived.

Our hope is that a new name, inclusive of the wide range of Watertown residents, can be recommended to the full Council as an action item from the Public Works Committee. Please let us know if you need any further information from us at this point and how we can best support you in this process.

On December 2, 2021, this office received a Petition to the City Council requesting that City begin the process of giving consideration to the renaming of the Columbus Delta in Watertown Square.

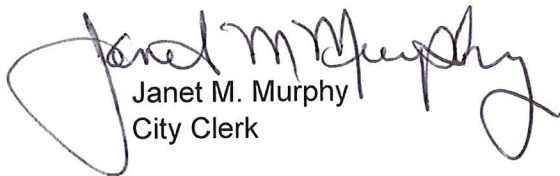
