- Documentation was as thorough as an application
- Brad Parsons Questions to Cameron Blair, Roman

- Is there a change in scope of research – no the R&D scope is the same
- Floorplan vivarium- coming later (3/2024) as an amendment
 - Disaster plan
 - IBC minutes on vivarium planning
- Request higher resolution floorplans
- Is there waste being generated on the 1st floor
 - Cameron – use 1st floor zone as overflow, or satellite accumulation for waste removal
- Movement of chemical waste between floors using elevators – use best practices
- Cameron – main accumulation area is above ground, on the 2nd floor
- Occupancy date 2/12
- Ralph Melee questions
 - Category 1 and 2?
 - Cameron – all category 1
 - Providing updated chemical plan
- Deb McEwan questions
 - Please update screening document that NHP samples are from a CRO
- 155 Arlington will be out of the facility by 3/2024
 - Commercial transport of material between sites
- No need for Board of Health review for the move to 212
- Board of Health will review for the vivarium
- Propose – amendments of floors plans, sample screening

Transition Bio – 85 Walnut

- Update suite number to 110; same space
- Ralph asked if any of the space
 - Getzabel said the floor plans cover all of the space
- Getzabel submitted chemical hygiene plan in the original application
- Deb asked if there was an IBC meeting for the move
 - Getzabel said there was not one, but one will come up in 1/2024
 - Mia said if the scope, and procedures are not changing, then an IBC meeting is not needed
- Renewal paper work is needed in December

- Sarah – Consultant from Safety Partners
- Foci – covalent small molecule for serious immune disease
- Company Founded in 2021
- 28,000 Sq FT50/50 labs / offices
- 2 tissue culture suites (200 sq ft) - BSL-2
- Whole facility is badge access
- Initial lab entry is to an enclosed area for donning PPE prior to entering active lab space
- Recombinant DNA
 - Commercially available transfected cell lines
 - Human primary cells to test small molecule on protein binding and cell uptake / clearance
 - In the event they cannot find a line they generate one
 - Only buy 4th generation LVV
 - Volume < 100mL
- Use whole blood; cells derived from whole blood
- No toxins are used
- Last IBC – 8/2023
- Brad Question
 - Floor plan – is there negative pressure in [] room if both doors are open
 - What types of gas
 - Argon in the future
- Mia questions
 - IBC minutes and agents list need to indicate whole human blood
 - Is there a vendor?
 - Yes its commercially screened
 - Deb
 - What cells will be separated from whole blood
 - PBMCs
 - Ralph
 - Floorplan
 - BSL2 in corner outside of area
 - Storage
- Proposed updates
 - Agent list
 - Floor plan as submitted with different color for storage
- Motion to submit to board of health with updated agent list – Mia; Deb second
 - All vote to approve
 - Next Board of Health is 11/15
 - Maureen will send details
